General Updates

When you have an international applicant with an interpreter present, explain to the interpreter the maneuvers you will ask the applicant to perform. Then, have the interpreter relay these instructions to the applicant.

The use of an interpreter can only be used prior to the test beginning. The interpreter cannot be in the vehicle during the test.

- 18 and older can test after holding Beginner's Permit for 30 days. Under 18 must still hold Permit for 180 days.
- All directions MUST be read verbatim from the 447-EX(IS).

Following Distance:

- AAA – 3 seconds
- AAMVA – 4 seconds
- SCDMV has adopted AAMVA's standard.
- All Road Tests will be scored based on the 4-second standard.



General Updates



3 Attempt Rule:

- If an applicant does not understand the directions and performs a maneuver incorrectly, they are given three (3) attempts to complete the maneuver before the test is marked as an automatic failure (XF-43, Non-Cooperation).
- Do not confuse attempting to perform the maneuver correctly with failure to understand instructions. If the applicant clearly understands what is required and an automatic failure occurs, they do not get another opportunity to perform the maneuver.

Emergency Vehicles:

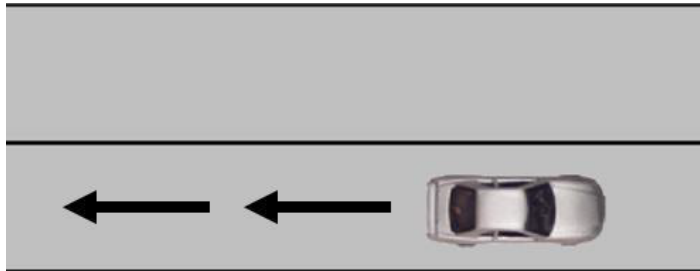
- Applicants must pull to the right as far as possible for any emergency vehicle approaching from the rear or the opposite direction.
- If an emergency vehicle is stopped on the side of a single-lane road, the applicant must slow down and move as far to the left as possible. On a multi-lane road, the applicant must move over to the left lane if it is possible, and safe to do so. Failure to move over when/if traffic allows will result in an automatic failure (XF-42, Violation).



Basic Control Skills

Straight-Line Backing:

- DMV Examiners use Option B: Please pull off the road and bring your vehicle to a smooth stop, now turn your wheels full lock to the (left or right). When it is safe, I want you to take control of the vehicle and back into the road. Back straight in the lane as long as it is clear behind you or until you are asked to stop. Do you have any question?



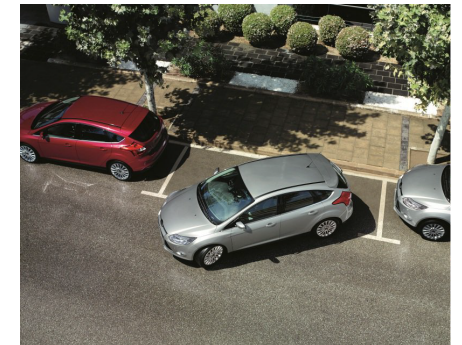
Three-Point Turnabout:

- One (1) or two (2) tires leaving the road surface is marked as an encroachment.
- All four (4) tires leaving the road surface is marked as an automatic failure (XF-43, Non-Cooperation).



Parallel Parking:

- Please ensure applicants have moved past the front barricade before they start backing into the parking space.
